Some businesses camouflage themselves by putting their best foot forward in the customer service department.

Charging a price that is lower than the industry standard may not be a positive move.

Cheap services may be exactly that, which makes them something to be leery of. On the other hand, if the company has been able to do creative calculations to make affordability a key ingredient of their services then this should be considered.
