Natural History Museum

Why did the dinosaurs disappear? The museum is found in South Kensington near Hyde Park. The Curators definitely merit all the praise as they have put up with amazing shows. There are real life exhibits on view like the housefly's life cycle. The highlights are the ecology studio, Mineral studio, Mammals gallery an Earth's gallery.

Imperial War Museum

Imperial war museum holds the wartime experiences from the 1st and 2nd World Wars, found in South London. Visitors come face to face with the wartime accounts ; can see variety of military weapon display, tanks, one- man submarine and a human torpedo. Be astounded when you look at a mustang, spitfire, an atomic bomb surrounding and a fishing ship that hold witness to the Dunkirk evacuation in 1940. One interesting fact about the museum is that until the year 1930, this place was a lunatic asylum.

NZ Design Museum

The NZ design museum displays the finest in world modern NZ design products from a range of classic cars to home utensils. The museum is a classy white building, that has the programme of changing exhibitions. The 1st floor of the museum 'Review studio' displays new ideas and runs non permanent exhibitions, while the top floor is the 'Collections gallery' which is all of the time growing.
